An Apprenticeship Framework programme offers a combination of learning in the workplace, formal off the job training and the opportunity to practice and embed new skills in a real work context.

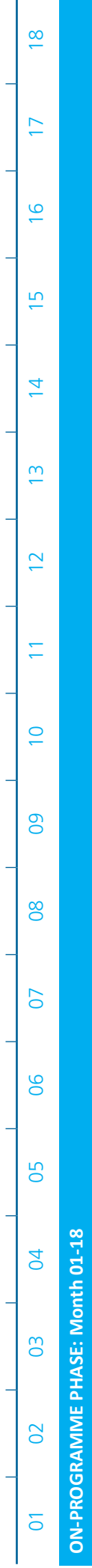

## ON-PROGRAMME PHASE: Month 01-18



### INDUCTION: First 6 weeks

- Programme overview/ unit selection
- English and maths diagnostic – with Functional Skills support (where identified)
- Health and Safety, Equality and Diversity, Prevent and British Values
- Expectations and induction targets

### ON-PROGRAMME: Month 01 -18

- Monthly classroom workshops off-the-job training – Delivery and achievement of Level 3 Diploma in Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools
- 4-6 weekly work-based assessment visits
- Independent learning
- Functional Skills English, maths and ICT at the required level (Classroom-based on day-release day)
- Completion of Employer Rights and Responsibilities
- Personal learning and thinking skills
- 10 weekly progress reviews
- Development of e-portfolio
- Health and Safety, Equality and Diversity, Prevent and British Values

### CERTIFICATION: Final 4-6 weeks

- CACHE Level 3 Diploma in Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools (Combined Competency/ Knowledge Aim)
- Functional Skills in English, maths and ICT
